

# FISA WORLD MASTERS CAMPING RULES

## CAMPING

- You must be 18 years of age or older to register for a campsite.
- Use picnic sites and other day use areas only between the hours of 6 a.m. and 11 p.m. Access to the lower island will be restricted at 11pm.
- Campgrounds and other recreation sites can be used only for recreation purposes.
- A single site may be used by up to 4 persons with 1 vehicle. Visitors will be monitored while they are on the camp grounds.
- Only registered campers are permitted after 11 p.m.
- Observe required check out times. If you are late leaving, you will be charged for any additional nights.
- In campgrounds, camp only in designated sites. Do not set up a campsite in the wooded area or in the designated pathways.
- A campsite must be occupied the first night of the period the facilities have been reserved. You must put a tent or a camper on the site after you have registered and paid for the site so it is obviously occupied.
- Camping equipment cannot be left unattended for more than 24 hours without permission by the camping coordinator.
- St. Catharines World Rowing will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.
- Remove all personal property and put your trash in refuse containers when leaving.
- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. Turn off all music and refrain from any loud activities or noises. If a neighbour camper is disturbing you, please bring it to the attention of the camping coordinator.
- Generators may only be used in the camping area between the hours of 7am and 9pm. There is a 3 hour/day maximum time limit on running a generator.
- Pets are not allowed on Henley Island for the duration of the Regatta.
- Use of fireworks or other explosives is prohibited within campgrounds and other recreation sites.
- Alcohol consumption will be closely monitored. No alcoholic beverage will be allowed out of the camping area. Any excessive alcohol consumption or attempting to remove alcohol from the camping area may result in confiscation of the alcohol, or removal of individuals from the camping area. Refunds will not be given in this circumstance.

## KEEP SITES CLEAN

- Keep your site clean of all litter and waste. Keep garbage, litter and foreign substances out of the trees and grounds.
- Throw all garbage and litter in dumpsters and recycle bins provided for this purpose or take it with you.
- Garbage containers are reserved for the use of campers and visitors only.
- Water is for personal use only. Washing cars, boats or RVs is prohibited.

- Do not wash food, clothing, dishes or personal items at water stations. Use water faucets for drawing water only.
- Use restroom facilities properly. Do not throw garbage, litter, or other foreign substances in toilets and plumbing fixtures.

### **CAMPFIRE SAFETY**

- Obey restrictions on fires. There is to be **NO OPEN FLAME** throughout the course of the regatta.

### **OPERATION OF VEHICLES**

- Camping vehicles are to be parked in the overflow parking lot for the duration of the stay.
- Parking passes will be distributed by parking staff upon arrival and must be displayed at all times.
- Ontario traffic laws apply in all parking lots and roadways on Henley Island.
- No vehicle is allowed to be parked in the RV Parking lot unless specifically designated to pull a trailer. Vehicles dropping off camping equipment will be limited to 15 minutes in the drop off zone before being asked to move.
- When operating vehicles of any kind, do not damage the land or vegetation, or disturb wildlife.
- Do not block, restrict, or interfere with the use of roads or trails.

### **PROPERTY**

- Do not carve, chop, cut, or damage any live trees.
- Preserve and protect the environment. Leave natural areas the way you find them.
- Buildings, structures, or enclosed areas may be entered only when expressly opened to the public.

### **Public Behaviour**

- No fighting or boisterous behaviour.
- Keep noise at a reasonable level.

### **Audio Devices**

- Operate any audio device such as a radio or musical instrument within reason, so that it will not disturb other campers.
